- **Must** attend all mandatory CCYM meetings. Meetings are held throughout the year and held in all 4 districts of the Peninsula-Delaware Conference. There are typically 5 meetings per year plus events. Adult leaders are usually able to assist with carpooling. You will be informed of all dates before accepting a CCYM position.
- **Must** attend the 2016 Youth Rally, and must make a faithful effort to attend as many other CCYM-sponsored events as possible.
- **Must** be a student in grades 9-12 during the 2015-2016 academic year.
- **Must** have the permission and support of his/her parent(s).

Make no mistake, this is a big commitment! If you're still interested, please talk it over with God and with your parents and then complete the application and return it to Rev. Scot McClymont at the address above by Friday, January 30, 2015. All applicants will be notified whether they have been accepted or not by the end of February.
